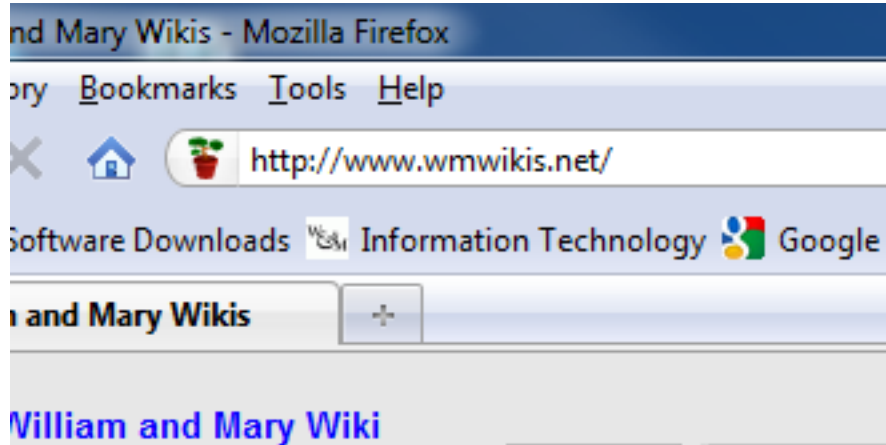
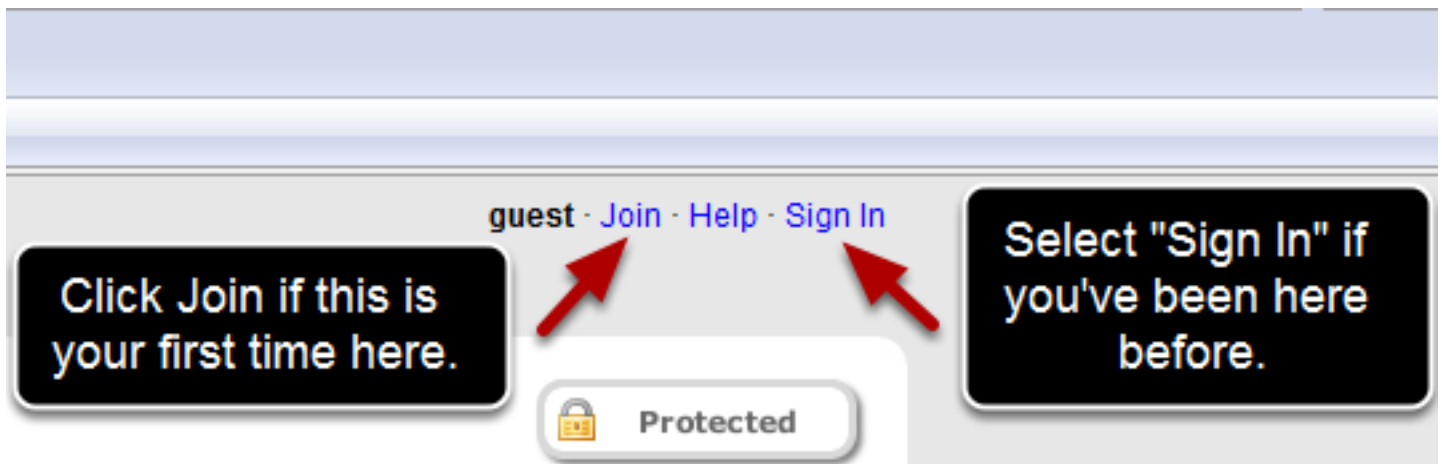


How to Make a New Wiki

Public

Everyone can view and edit your pages.

Protected

Everyone can view pages, only wiki members can edit them.

Private

Only wiki members can view and edit pages.

1. Give your wiki a name. This will determine the url (electronic address) of your wiki). 2. Select whether you'd like your wiki to be public, protected, or private. You can always change this setting later. 3. Leave the wiki template area blank or select one of the existing templates if you are required to do so.

- To invite new members, click on **Manage Wiki** and **Invite People**.
- To change your wiki's colors or theme, click on **Manage Wiki** and **Look and Feel**.
