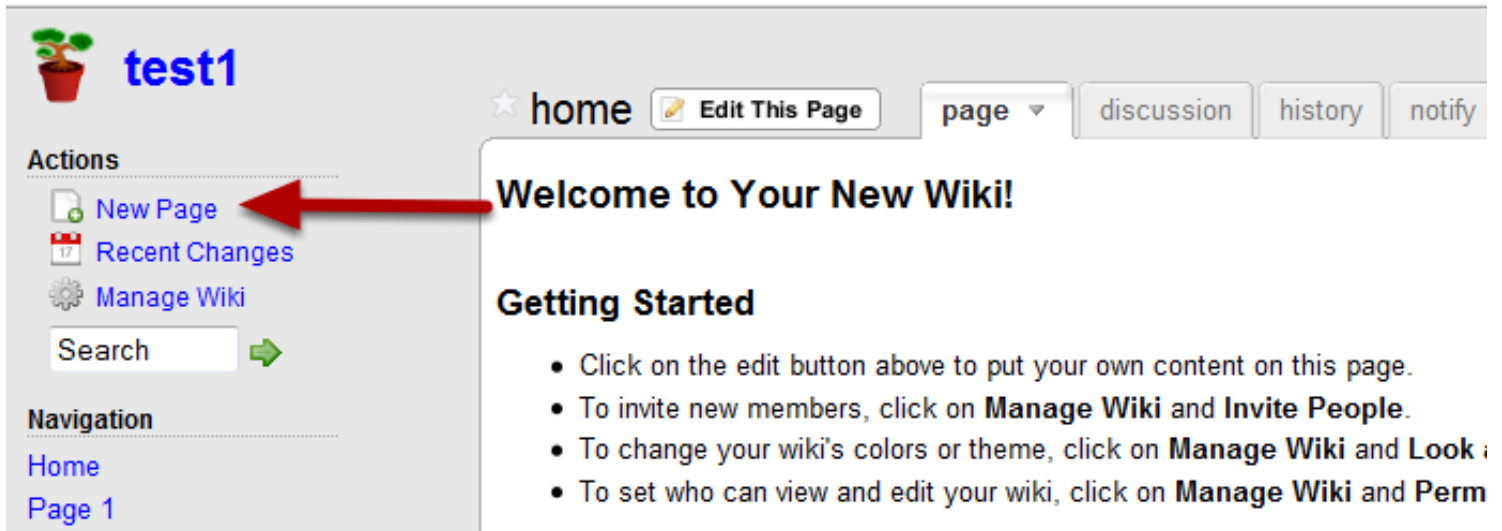


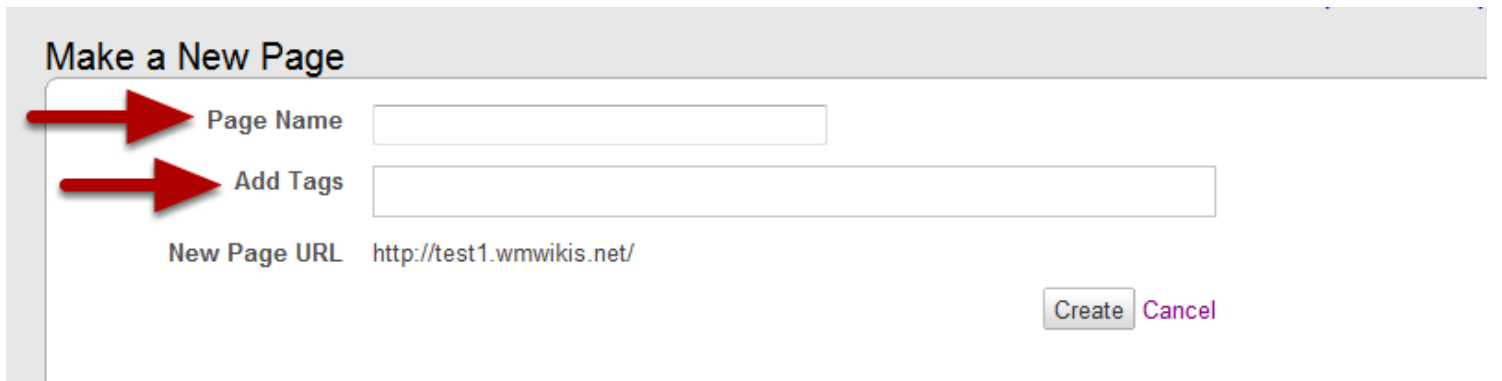
# How to create a new page in WM Wikis

This tutorial will demonstrate two methods for creating a new page in your WM Wiki.

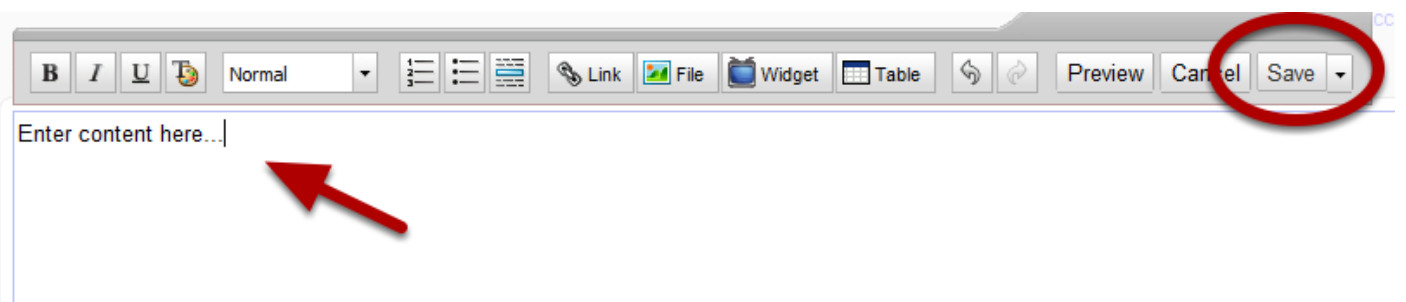
## 1. Follow the New Page menu option



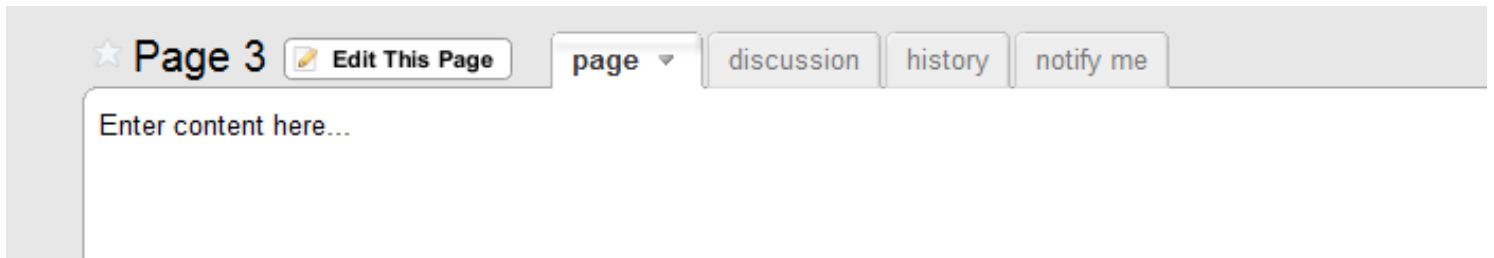
Find the **New Page** link from your sidebar menu.



Give your page a name. Then, you may add tags to your page. Tags are words that will help to identify the content of your page. You may leave the Add Tags field blank if you wish.

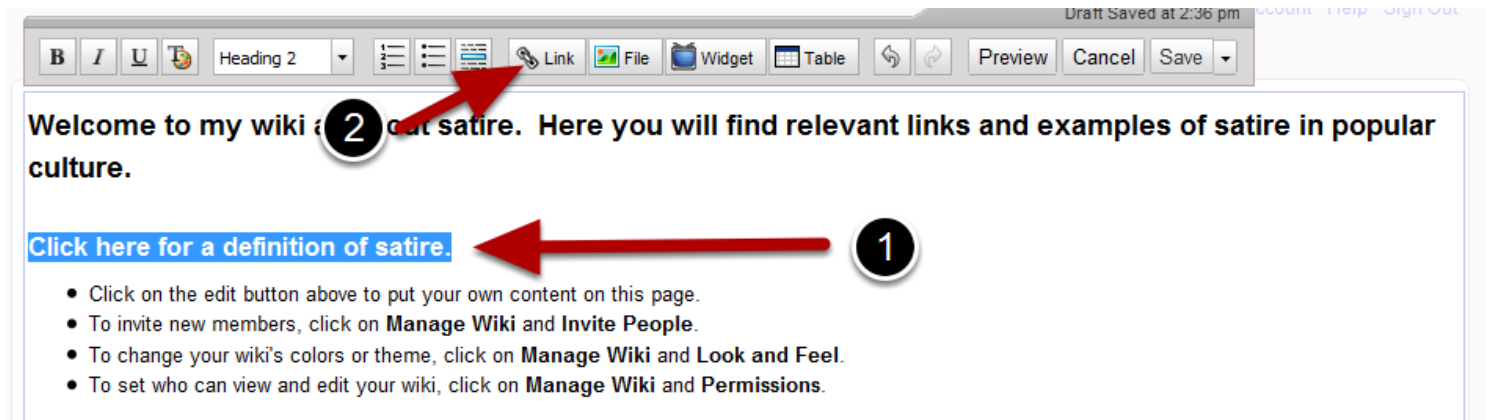


Your page now appears in editing mode. You can begin typing to enter content on your new page. Remember to click **save** when you are done. You can always come back to add or edit a page at any time.



Once you click **save**, you will see you page in it's normal layout.

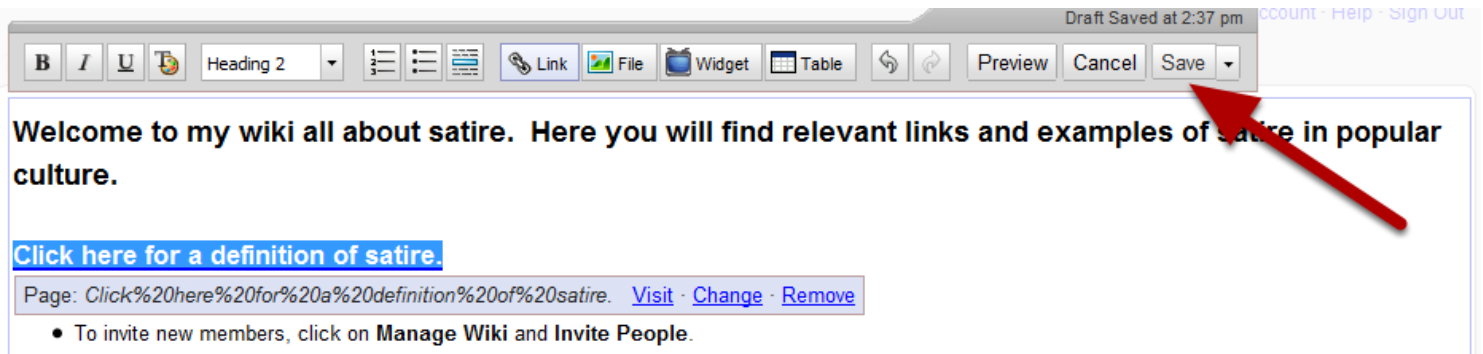
## 2. Add a linked page as you are writing content



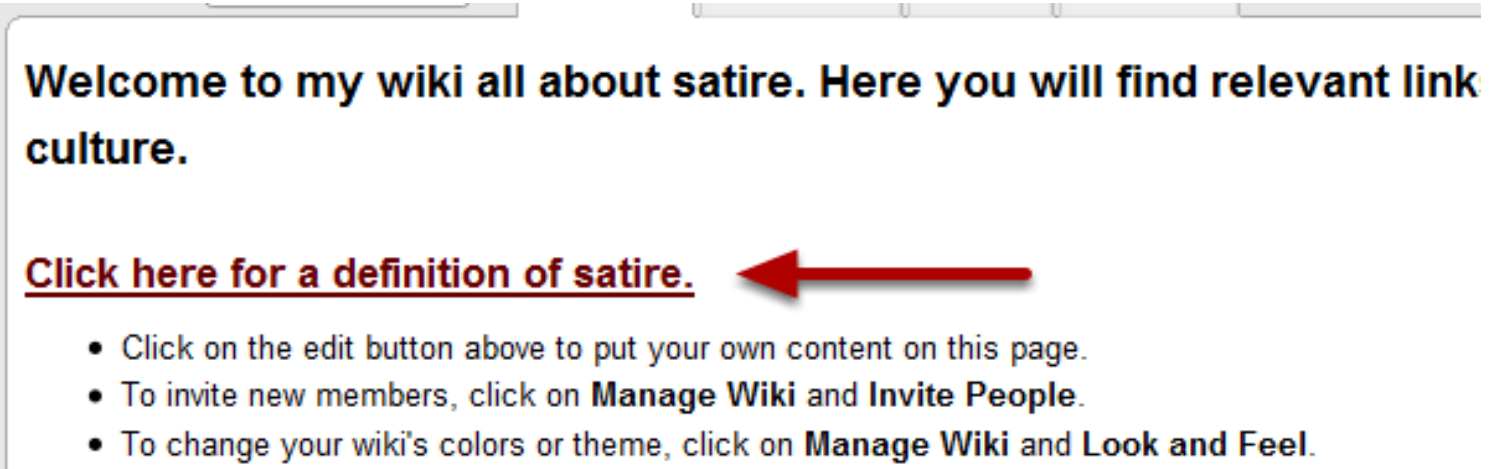
Sometimes you may think of a page that should appear within a page (as a link) as you are entering content. You can create a new page while you are writing your content. To do so, first highlight the text that you wish to appear as the link to your new page. Then, click the **link** button in your editing toolbar.



Click **Add Link**.



Remember to click **save** to save your changes.



You will now see a link when you view your page in it's normal view. Try clicking the link.



When you do, you will a message indicating that your page does not yet exist. Simply click the **edit button** link to begin entering content on your newly created page. Remember to save your changes.
